
Question - How many K12 students are prepared for College level English and Math?


Dashboard - Gateway Course Completion

Blue = # of gateway courses completed, Grey = % to goal











Dashboard – Enrollment 20 and younger cohort


What proportion of traditionally underserved students have access to complete a degree at SLCC?

Enrollment – Pell Recipients













How long does it take students to earn a credential?



SLCC Goals	High Impact Strategies
Partnerships with K-12 to strengthen college readiness and access.	A K12-to-College Readiness and Access Taskforce that collaborates regularly to cultivate a common set of beliefs and practices among practitioners throughout the educational spectrum.
Improving access and completion for students traditionally underserved.	Expand SLCC communication through the development and implementation of a unified SLCC communication software to support the timely, appropriate and consistent communication with prospective and continuing student populations.
